Holy Holly Day The Battle of Nantwich

Saturday 23rd January 2021

When Civil War broke out in 1642, Nantwich declared support for the Parliamentarians against the Royalists. On the 25th of January 1644 a major battle broke out in Nantwich. The Parliamentarians were victorious and hundreds of Royalist prisoners were captured.

Every year the Sealed Knot Society parade through the town in costume and re-enact this historic battle on Mill Island.
