Welcome to Nantwich Market

Nantwich has been a Market Town since the 16th century. The first Market Hall was built on High Street in 1720 where the Town Square is located today, after a donation of £600 from the Prince of Wales. A first floor Session Room was constructed but this was removed during the rebuild in 1759, when part of the building tragically collapsed. In 1869 a new Market Hall and road named Market Street was built opposite Nantwich's beautiful church, St Mary's—otherwise known as 'The Cathedral of South Cheshire'. This is the popular traditional Market Hall still used today. It cost £2000 to build and the land was donated by John Tollemache Esq. M.P whose coat of arms can be viewed on the building alongside those of Nantwich (malbedeug) and Cholmondeley.
