We would prefer traders to utilize contactless payments rather than handling cash where possible. The layout of this area and the stalls will be setup to ensure social distancing can be met. Market Traders Rules

1. Please use hand sanitiser and wash your hands regularly.
2. Please wear a mask/face covering at all times.
3. No physical contact to be made with any members of the public.
4. Social distancing to be adhere to where possible (unless working the stall with someone from your immediate household).
5. Contactless payments preferred over handling cash.
6. Only serve customers from one side of your stall as directed by us.
7. Our signage, procedures and direction from our staff must be followed at all times.
8. Serve clients quickly to reduce and congestion.

Failure to comply with these rules will result in you being asked to leave.
